First Queen's Freddie Mercury got a biopic treatment, and now Elton John, the other icon of '70s rock, gets what's coming to him on the big screen. Rocketman, which opens on May 31, portrays Taron Egerton as a pompous singer. It chronicles his life from a childhood piano prodigy who grew up in suburban England through his rise to fame, fighting drugs and eventually recovering. A showcase for Elton John's best songs Rocketman may tell Sir Elton's life story, but this jukebox musical is also a showcase for his huge musical output, with screenwriters using his songs to help the film move forward. Egerton took it to sing all the songs in the film (with soundtrack producer Giles Martin overseeing the production), which offered his own interpretation to fans for such well-known hits. It was so important that I composed and recorded music to tune the taron, John has said. I wanted his interpretation of me through Bernie's lyrics and my music - not just acting. That's not surprising given the depth of his production in recent decades. However, fans may miss songs like Daniel, Levon or Sacrifice. Also missing is Candle in the Wind, originally written in honour of Marilyn Monroe and rewritten in 1997 in honour of Princess Diana. Fans also won't hear his songs from the 1994 soundtrack to the Lion King, such as Can You Feel the Love Tonight and Circle of Life. What Egerton says about singing Elton John songs during a conversation on Beats 1, John and Egerton talked about what it was like for the younger actor to reinterbot some of the most famous songs in pop music history. It's not easy to sing Bernie and my songs. And you've managed to do that with a lot of aplomb. Are you having a hard time singing them? John asked for his alter ego on the screen. I think it would have been harder without you being so encouraging. I think it was a big part of the enabler and made me feel relaxed enough they're the way we have them, Egerton replied. We also find hope, curiosity and love in the moments we capture in life as we chase our dreams and also find good friends along the way.
